A native of Buenos Aires, **Andres Amarilla** began dancing tango over 20 years ago, at age 11. He had the amazing fortune to study with three of the most important figures in tango (Gustavo Naveira, Juan Carlos Copes, and Rodolfo Dinzel), and to perform with their dance companies, all before the age of 18. During the 1990s, Andres collaborated with Fabian Salas, Gustavo Naveira, Chicho Frumboli and others in closed rehearsals in which the movement vocabulary and methods of analysis that we now know as "nuevo tango" were born. Andres began teaching tango in Buenos Aires in 1997, spent 2 years developing the tango community in Belo Horizonte, Brazil, and launched a worldwide teaching career in 2006 with his partner, and now wife, Meredith Klein. Since then, they have taught in over 30 cities on 4 continents.

Andres believes that good tango dancing in any style requires a strong foundation in traditional tango. His group classes in Philadelphia during the month of February will help students strengthen this foundation.
